Taxpayers in Maine have been dealt blow after blow by their state and local government for years. According to the Tax Foundation, during the past three decades Maine has consistently had one of the highest state and local tax burdens.

As if that wasn't bad enough, local property tax collections are enormous. They totaled \$1,567,940,000 in FY 2000. That amounted to \$1,233 per capita, which ranks 6th highest nationally.

No wonder the people of Maine have taken to firing cannons and staging tea parties.

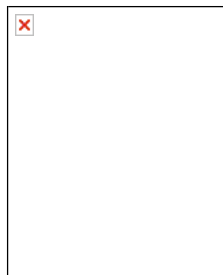
